Dear Parents.

I hope that you have enjoyed your first few weeks of summer break! My prayer is that this will be a relaxing and rejuvenating time for you and your family. Here at St. Henry we have been busy with wrapping up the end of the 2023-2024 school year, coordinating summer projects, and preparing for the 2024-2025 school year. If you received an email from Cindy in the last few days about overdue lunch or after care accounts please get those amounts submitted as soon as possible. You can stop by the school office or you can mail us a check. I also want to encourage you to consider volunteering for Bingo at least one week this summer. It is only a couple of hours out of your summer and is a great opportunity to reconnect with other parents and serve our school. Sign-up information is below.

Our summer projects are getting underway. The upgrade to our network began this week and will continue into next week. Next week they will begin asbestos abatement on the library and tech lab floors to prepare for the renovation work that will be happening in those spaces. Window installation in the grade school building should begin next week. We are so excited for these projects to be moving forward and cannot wait to see all of the ways that our students will benefit next year!

I also wanted to give you a quick hiring update. We have all of our K-8 positions filled for next year at this point with the exception of our second 4th grade teacher. The position has been offered to someone and we are waiting for their official acceptance. We are excited about the faculty that we have in place for next year and we are looking forward to a great year of growth for our students. We do have two Preschool Aide positions open. One is full time and one is part time. We are also looking for After Care workers for next year. If you know of someone who might be interested please have them reach out to me!

For those of you who aren't VIRTUS trained, please check out the information below regarding upcoming classes so you can volunteer at our school! Remember that you are not able to be in our classrooms for parties or go on field trips unless your have received this training.

I also wanted to remind you about the many great events happening around the Diocese this summer. We have our Vacation Bible School here at St. Henry in July so be sure to sign your students up for that. There will also be a St. Henry Night at Brookwood Swim Club. We hope to see you all there! Also, for our Jr. High students there is the Summer Connect Junior High Event and the middle school Pro-Life Boot Camp. You can find more information below about those events.

From the Pastor's Desk

We have some exciting things happening this summer to upgrade our school facilities! One of these upgrades is that the elementary school building will be receiving all new windows and doors! Money raised through this year's Derby Night at St. Henry event and unspent funds from past Cru Giving fundraisers made it possible for us to replace all of the windows on the parking lot side of the building. We are able to complete the windows on the rest of the building due to a very

generous, anonymous donor. We were also able to use EANS funding (emergency government funds from COVID) to pay for the labor and installation costs for this project. Thank you to Principal Kimberly Wagner, Don Bodner our Business Manager, and Sean Duffy our Maintenance Director, who have worked hard to coordinate and prepare our building for this project. Sean especially has put in many labor hours to prepare our buildings for this project as well as our upcoming library renovation.

In light of this project, please be prepared for the temporary closure of the driveway under the school "skywalk." (I always say to other pastors, "I bet your school doesn't have a skywalk!") That driveway will be closed for 6-7 weeks during the summer due to window construction workers having their vehicles and supplies there. Thank you for your patience!

I am also excited to share about two teacher appreciation and retention efforts that have been in the works. Throughout this school year, a group of parents worked in conjunction with Mrs. Wagner to raise funds to give our teachers an end-of-the-year bonus to express their appreciation for all that they do for our school. Due to these efforts, all faculty and staff members will be receiving a \$500 bonus. The other effort is that we will be increasing our tuition discount for teachers next year. We will be offering all contracted teachers a 50% discount on tuition for their children and a 25% discount to all full-time staff members. This is a great way to help draw and retain quality teachers to our school. Our gratitude is beyond measure to everyone involved in making these projects happen. We appreciate our teachers who give so much of themselves — past, present ... and future!
