Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe we have only been back in school for a week and a half! I feel like we have hit a good groove already and our students are doing great work! Thank you to everyone who made it to Vision Night on Wednesday evening. I know that it was a busy night with St. Henry's very first football game taking place! It is so exciting that our students were able to take part in this historic event whether they were on the winning team or not.

I wanted to remind parents that while any close-toed shoes with a back are acceptable in accordance with our student handbook, it is important that students make sure they are wearing tennis shoes on days that they have gym. Wearing boots or other shoes that do not have good soles to them makes it difficult for them to participate in gym class and if they cannot participate it may have an impact on their grade in that class.

An exciting addition to our building this week is that we received the new cafeteria chairs that we had ordered! They are red and black and add a feel of school spirit to our cafeteria space. These chairs were able to be purchased due to EANS money, which is money that was made available to schools in the wake of COVID by the government. That money has been a blessing and has been used to purchase allowable items for our facilities as well as updated curriculum for many of our classes that give them more online options in the event that we would ever need to do online learning.

Finally, you should have received information about our Mumkins sale this week. That sale started yesterday and all orders will be delivered on September 24. The funds raised are used to benefit the school as a whole. The money from last year is being used for the door wraps on our entryways. The gym was done right before school started and the Jr. High building will be completed in the near future. Once the window installation is complete they will also be put on the Elementary School building. After we see how much money we raise this year we will evaluate the needs of the school and determine where to allocate those funds.


