Self control is being in control of our emotions, thoughts, words, and actions.



#### **SHDHS Looking for Swim Team Members**



To give parents choices in educational opportunities for their children, are you in favor of enabling the General Assembly to

Every state surrounding Kentucky has multiple educational choice

programs. These programs help cover the cost of non-public school tuition for eligible families. These programs sometimes cover educational expenses beyond education, including special needs therapies, textbooks, and technology.

Kentucky has no educational choice program, but efforts are underway to change that. The 2024 General Assembly passed a Kentucky Constitution Amendment bill, and the Amendment will be on the November 5, 2024, ballot for voter approval.

Kentucky students, parents, and teachers deserve the best opportunities that are right for them. What you need to know about voting YES ON 2 ...

#### Amendment 2 will:

- Empower parents to have more control over their child's education
- Give more opportunities to all students regardless of their background
- Provide more opportunities for students with special needs
- Result in a pay raise for teachers as it has in our neighboring states, Ohio and Indiana
- · Increase funds for Kentucky education

#### The Facts:

- Kentucky is one of two states (North Dakota) that does not offer students and parents educational opportunities from school choice.
- Every state around Kentucky has educational opportunities like those in Amendment 2.
- As it stands today, wealthy students have school choice in Kentucky. It is the less advantaged students who are not able to seek the education that fits their needs.
- Kentucky's education structure was established in 1891. A lot has changed since then, but the structure has not.
- Amendment 2 does not create any new programs. That decision is up to Governor Beshear and the Legislature to determine what any programs may or may not look like.

This event is open to 6th, 7th, and 8th-grade families. Registration will open in October, so mark your calendars now!


#### HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST WORKSHOP (OPTIONAL)
