The Empowering God's Children Safe Environment Program will provide its first training to our students from 11/11/24-11/22/24. The goal is to assist in the monumental mission of protecting children from abuse. Our trained staff will be delivering one safe environment lesson to your youth to support them in learning about their safety rights and boundaries, so that they have tools to protect themselves. Lessons are age-appropriate and designed to help our children recognize their boundaries and empower them to protect themselves when safe adults are not immediately available. 


### First Annual St. Henry Christmas Cookie Pack

### 2024 Facilities Assessment

### SHP

SHP (Simply Helping People) is a dynamic team of architects, designers and engineers that perform building and architectural assessments for the Diocese of Covington.

St. Henry had SHP perform a full facilities assessment of our campus. This included both the elementary and junior high school buildings.

A maintenance committee was created to review the report, recommended solutions, and cost/budget impacts.

We wish to share the highlights of that report and our next steps with the St. Henry community.

### Maintenance Priorities

- HVAC
- Pneumatics System
- Electrical Service
- Kitchen Exhaust

The boilers are past their end of life and experience limited/inefficient functionality. The pneumatics system is broken. Without it, we are heating and cooling the school at the same time. The electrical service may need to be replaced to work with a modern HVAC solution. We are partnering with Duke to test its capabilities. Our partners @ SHP have given us several options to replace/upgrade our existing systems to correct our major issues. The cost impact to St Henry for the repairs/upgrades are

~\$1.5 million. The proposed solution; a VRF= Variable Refrigerant Flow HVAC for the campus would eliminate the need for boilers, a pneumatic system, and would save \$ on utilities... MORE TO COME!
