Dear Parents.

We are blessed to have been able to get to spend some time with our students this week with all of the snow that prevented many schools from being in session. As you know, we are expecting more snow this afternoon. Hopefully it should not be significant enough to impact our ability to be in school on Monday. If you have not been receiving communications from the school regarding closings and delays, please reach out so we can get that fixed!

Next week we begin our Winter MAP testing. Please make sure that your students are getting a good night of sleep and a healthy breakfast each morning so they are ready to test. As we remind our students, this is not a test you can study for and it does not impact your grades. We just ask that students do their best as these tests give us good data on areas where our students need support and areas where they are excelling. We do have two school goals. The first is that as a school we place in at least the 62nd percentile for achievement for all four subject areas (math, reading, language usage, and science). The reward for meeting this goal is an out of uniform day. We also have a little harder goal as a school, to be at or above the 65th percentile in either math or reading and at or above the 75th percentile in language usage or science while being at least in the 62nd percentile for the remaining two subject areas. The reward for meeting this goal is a PJ day, watching a movie as a school, and no homework on that day. When you look at these percentages they might seem low, but being in the 62nd percentile means that we performed better than 61% of schools in the country. That is a huge achievement! These goals are based off of our Fall MAP testing achievements and I am confident that our students have the ability to do amazing things!

As you may know, Catholic Schools Week is coming up on the last week of January. It is a very fun week where we celebrate the many wonderful things about being a Catholic School and all of the people that make Catholic schools possible. There is a schedule below that includes all of the out of uniform/dress up days and information on how to register for certain events and volunteer to help. We are looking forward to celebrating this fun week, starting with our Open House on January 26. If you know of anyone who is considering sending their children to St. Henry, Open House is a great opportunity for them to learn more about the school.

The Lady Crusader Invitational also continues through the next week. We hope you can stop out to see our girls play!

YOUTH FLAG FOOTBALL


Get ready for an exciting introduction to the world of football!


