CRS Rice Bowls

One of our favorite Lenten traditions is to support Catholic Relief Services through their CRS Rice Bowl program. CRS Rice Bowl is the Lenten program of Catholic Relief Services, the official relief and development agency of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Our sixth graders gave a presentation to all classrooms this week and each student was given a CRS Rice Bowl to bring home and can collect lose change. The bowls should be returned to school by March 31.

Rooted in the history of the Eucharistic Congress, CRS Rice Bowl invites Catholics and faith communities in the United States to encounter God and our global family throughout Lent by practicing the **pillars of prayer**, **fasting and almsgiving**. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 120 different countries each year. Twenty-five percent of donations to CRS Rice Bowl stay in the local diocese, supporting hunger and poverty alleviation efforts. Mr. Miller visited with grades K-5 to talk about his book series of "The Adventures of Sammy the Wonder Dachshund." This series stars Sammy, a daring dog who works as a fact-checker for the internet. Mr. Miller creates each illustration by cutting and layering construction paper in a process that can take up to 30 hours per page. Mr. Miller is a resident of Charleston, South Carolina, and has spent more than a decade visiting schools around the country, reading his books, sharing the original artwork and discussing the writing process. We were excited that Mr. Miller was able to visit and spend an afternoon celebrating literacy with us!



for those who don't want to walk or stay late. Shifts are available the **third week of the month**, 5:00-7:00 PM and 5:15-7:30 PM.


Bingo Caller
